REGIONALS: The Regional Qualifier for Nationals (Masters level courses with modified Masters rules). Offered for Regular, Specials, and Veterans dogs. No Q's are available for regionals. Dogs are not required to have any titles to enter the Regionals. This event is open to all dogs registered with AAC and over the age of 18 months. All dogs must enter and run 2 Standard, 2 Jumpers, and 2 Gamblers courses.

STEEPLECHASE: There will be an AAC sanctioned steeplechase (for Q's) run each morning before we run the Regional Courses. Judge is also Claude Dionne. You don't have to enter regionals to enter the Steeplechase. Use the Regional Entry Form in this premium to enter the Steeplechase.

ENTRY CLOSING DATE: Sunday, April 11, 2010

Notice to Exhibitors

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AAC rules and regulations including, but not limited to, the following:

This event will be held in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Agility Association of Canada (AAC). The obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the *AAC Official Rules and Regulations* and shall conform to AAC specifications.

All breeds and mixed breeds eighteen months of age and older (no exceptions) are eligible to compete. Blind, lame, or aggressive dogs are ineligible as are bitches in season, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance (judge's discretion).

All dogs must have an AAC Registration Number before their entries will be accepted in an AAC sanctioned trial. The registration form is available at www.aac.ca General Information, Official Forms. Dogs with numbers pending will not be eligible to compete.

No toys, food, or other training devices shall be allowed on the course.

All dogs must be **under control** (ie. penned, crated, or leashed) when not in the ring. Please take responsibility for your dogs and children. Any Exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviour may be asked by the Trial Committee to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds for entries if the dog or handler is *dismissed* from the competition for any reason.

ENTRIES

- The Canine Agility Association of Nova Scotia (CAANS) reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- Anyone not in good standing with AAC / CAANS will not be allowed to enter the trial.
- Cheques are made payable to CAANS and dated no later than the closing date.
- Refunds will not be given for cancellations after the closing date except for bitches in season or injury to a dog (veterinarian certificate required), or handler, which physically prevents them from competing. Refunds requested for any other reason will be handled on a case by case basis and will be at the discretion of the CAANS Trial Committee.
- By AAC rules, entries are not valid until payment of entry fees has been received or confirmed.

AAC CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Regular: Dogs will jump standard heights and course times as set by AAC rules.

Specials: Open to all dogs; Course times and jump heights will be as per AAC rules. Dogs may move from the Specials division to the Veterans division.

Veterans: For dogs 7 years of age or older in the case of dogs who have been competing in Regular classes; for dogs 5 years of age or older who have been competing in the Specials division for a minimum of one year. Once a dog has entered an official trial in the Veterans division, they may no longer compete in the Regular or Specials divisions. Course times and jump heights will be as per AAC rules.

VOLUNTEERS

It is extremely difficult to find timers and scribes for the Regional Championships as these people cannot be competing. If you have someone you'd like to volunteer, or would like to come out and volunteer even though you are not entered, please let Leslie know (leslie.lord@dal.ca). As in other years, ring crew duties will be performed by those competing once their class is complete.

RING READY!!

Exhibitors are required to check in at the gate for each event and be ready to run when it is their turn.

OBSTACLE FAMILIARIZATION / WARM-UP AREA

- There will be no obstacle familiarization.
- A warm-up area will be provided as required by AAC rules. The warm-up area is for the use of dogs that are about to run.

TRIAL INFORMATION:

Running Order for each day: Steeplechase; 3 Regionals Courses

Set-up times and Running Orders will be determined after the closing date. Entrants will be notified by e-mail.

FOOD:

There is no canteen onsite, but there is a number of fast-food restaurants close by.

DIRECTIONS:

Agridome (Exhibition Grounds) - Bible Hill, Truro

From either direction off the 102:

Exit 14 (Truro/Bible Hill) - turn left or right at exit depending on what direction you came from so that you pass the Giant Tiger store. Go 1 km (passing Staples/Ponderosa/Cdn Tire on the right) to set of lights (cemetery on left). Turn left at lights (Sears/Marks Work Warehouse will now be on your right) - road goes behind the mall. Go 2 km to a 4 way stop - turn left and follow road to 1st set of lights (1 km). Right at the lights, to Ryland Ave on the left (about 1 km). There is a sign for the Truro Raceway about ½ way to Ryland Ave (don't turn yet!). Go to Ryland Ave. and turn left on Ryland Ave. (big white building on corner) and go about ½ km. to the next sign that says Truro Raceway on the left. Now turn here... and there you are. The building is facing you on the left. The entrance is at the end near the racetrack.
