General Information:

Fetch Inc. would like to invite you to their AAC (Agility Association of Canada) sanctioned Agility Trial. This trial will be held at Fetch Inc. in Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

Schedule of Events:

4:00pm - Check-in & measurement

4:15pm - Judge's briefing

4:30pm - 1st Event

Familiarization/Warm-up:

Familiarization will **not** be available. Two jumps will be available for warm up throughout the trial.

Title Trial:

The dogs will be divided into four height groups. The Masters class is open to dogs that have an AADC title; the Masters games are open to dogs that have two corresponding Advanced Games Legs. The Advanced class is open to dogs that have an ADC title; the Advanced games are open to dogs who have a corresponding Starters Games Leg. Starters are open to dogs who have not obtained an ADC title. Starters Games events are open to dogs until they have earned two Q's under two different judges.

Obstacles:

A-frame, Dog Walk, Teeter, Weave Poles, Table, Flexible Tunnels, Collapsible Tunnel, Tire Jump, Ascending Spread Jump, Double Bar Jump, Single Bar Jumps.

Facilities:

The trial is an evening trial being held outside on sand with indoor crating and facilities available.

Dog Aggression:

All dogs must be kept in an x-pen, crate or on leash when not in the ring (this includes the grounds, parking lot and fields). Any dog engaging in aggressive behavior at any time will be required to leave the show grounds. In such cases, no refund of fees will be paid.

Directions to Fetch Inc.:

From Halifax International Airport:

- **HWY-102 S** via the ramp to **Halifax/Dartmouth**
- Take the exit on the **left** onto **HWY-118 S** toward **Halifax/HWY-111/HWY-103/Dartmouth**
- Take exit **13W** to merge onto **Akerley Blvd/HWY-107 W** toward **Akerley Blvd/Burnside Ind. Park**
- Continue to follow Akerley Blvd Turn **left** at **Joseph Zatzman Dr.**

From Halifax:

- Take the **MacKay Bridge to Dartmouth**, merge onto **HWY-111 N**
- Take exit **3** for **Burnside Industrial Park** toward **Highfield Park Dr.**, turn **left** at **Burnside Dr/Highfield Park Dr.**
- Continue to follow Burnside Dr., turn **left** at **Wright Ave**, and Turn **right** at **Joseph Zatzman Dr.**

Notice to Participants:

To keep the event running smoothly, you will be expected to keep track of the running order and to be in the "on deck" area TWO dogs prior to your run. Competitors who qualify for title in a trial prior to this one, may move up **providing** the information is received by the Trial Secretary **at least 5 days prior to the trial date**. Competitors, through the submission of an entry, acknowledge that they know the AAC rules and regulations. All dogs must have an AAC ID number. **NOTE: AAC regulations require the handler to obtain an ID card directly from the AAC; AAC ID cards will NOT be available for sale at the trial.**

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal, or in the event of inclement weather. Refunds will be issued for dogs that come into heat or are injured, providing a veterinarian's certificate is received by the Trial Secretary within 48 hours of the start of the trial.
