Entries will be accepted ONLINE ONLY at <http://www.agilityrocks.com>. Payment of entries is required by the closing date to be officially entered in the Trial. EMTs are the only form of payment being accepted, no password required as auto deposit is enabled. Please send a copy of the online entry confirmation by email to fetchtrial@outlook.com.

When the allotted number of runs has been reached on the Agility Rocks program, the program will stop accepting entries. Please email our Trial Secretary at fetchtrial@outlook.com to request that your name be added to the wait list for that day (do not send an entry, just a request). Confirmations will be emailed after the entry deadline. Contact the Trial Secretary at fetchtrial@outlook.com if you have not received your confirmation by Monday May 13, 2024.

Notice to Participants:

Please note that the trial is considered **CLOSED** when the maximum runs allowed is reached in Agility Rocks, or on May 3, 2024, whichever occurs first. There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the trial is considered **CLOSED**, except in the case of a change to a dog’s health status; injuries, bites in season, communicable disease, etc. Requests for refunds due to a change in a dog’s health status will only be considered if the request is received by the Trial Secretary twenty-four (24) hours prior to the start date of the trial; and a signed/dated note from a registered veterinarian professional is received within seven (7) calendar days from the start date of the trial. Any dog suspected of attending the trial with a communicable disease will be asked to leave the trial and no refund will be issued.

Competitors, through the submission of an entry, acknowledge that they know the AAC rules and regulations. All dogs must have an AAC ID number. AAC regulations require the handler to obtain an ID card directly from the AAC.

A grid will be posted to the Fetch Agility Trials Facebook group the week before the trial. If the grid is not full, jobs will be assigned. Please sign up for at least three jobs per trial. Thank you in advance. Without volunteers we would not be able to hold trials!

Familiarization and Warm-up: Familiarization will not be available. Two jumps will be available for warm-up throughout the trial. Please sanitize your hands before and after setting bars.

Obstacles: All obstacles conform to AAC specifications.

Dog conduct: All dogs must be kept under control. Any dog engaging in aggressive behaviour at any time will be required to leave. No refund of fees will be given.

Limited Entry: This is a limited entry trial based on number of runs. A waiting list of entries received after the limit is reached will be kept. In case of cancellations, spaces will be filled from the waiting list in the order entries are received.

Volunteers: All participants will be required to volunteer. A volunteer job grid will be posted. If you are unable to fulfill your volunteer duties, please arrange for a replacement.

Awards: Qualifying ribbons will be given for all event qualifiers, and flat ribbons will be given for 1st through 4th placement for all classes.

Facility: Outdoors on artificial turf. Indoor crating will **not** be available. Bathroom facilities are available.

AAC Class Descriptions

Masters: Open to all dogs that have earned an AADC title

Regular: Dogs will jump standard heights and course times as set by AAC Rules

Special: Open to all dogs. Course times and jump heights as set by AAC Rules

Veterans: For dogs 7 years of age or older for dogs competing in the regular class. For dogs 5 years

of age or older who have been competing in the Specials division for a minimum of 1 year. Once a dog has entered an official trial in the Veterans division, they may no longer compete in Regular or Specials divisions. Course times and jump heights as set by AAC Rules

FEO: For Exhibition Only. FEO entries are not eligible to “Q” nor are they eligible for placements. Participants must have an AAC number in order to enter. Toys are permitted in the ring, but may **not** be thrown. Handlers must attempt the course as numbered or as per Gamblers or Snookers rules.

Junior Handler: Junior Handlers must have their own AAC Junior Handler ID. A Junior Handler entered in the junior class may not compete in regular classes at the same AAC Trial.
