DIRECTIONS TO FTLOD! ARENA:

From Confederation Bridge: Travel to Cornwall PE, Take the **second** exit off of the new bypass highway. Turn **RIGHT** off of ramp thru new round-about. Follow road to the set of lights at Meadowbank Rd. in Cornwall (Pizza Delight, Tim Horton’s etc) Travel straight across highway and go approx. 6 minutes, down Meadowbank Rd. over the West River Bridge. About 1.5km after the bridge turn Left onto Route 19 (Sign saying Rocky Point) 1km down the road veer Left staying on Route 19 at the Afton Community Hall. Counting from that intersection, we are the 6th driveway down on your Right.

RULE CHANGE JAN 1, 2018 – All handlers must now present their height cards at check-in. To speed up this process we are asking that those with finished cards to please enclose a copy of your completed height card with your entry, so we can check you in before the trial. Those that still need a measurement to finish their cards, you can bring your card with you and check in during the measuring process.

Trial Information

This trial is being held in conjunction with a UKI trial scheduled on Friday May 17th

Measuring:

Regular measuring will be done Saturday morning at 7:00am only prior to the beginning of judging.

Volunteer List:

The volunteer list will be posted at the gate the day of the trial. Please check the volunteer list carefully and if there is a conflict, try and resolve the conflict amongst yourselves, however, make sure the changes are printed on the volunteer list.

HEIGHT CARDS

The AAC has been having some issues with not receiving proof of height cards at trials. FTLOD! requires you to send along a copy of your dog's height card along with your trial entry (regardless of how many years your dog has been trialing or if you have trialed here before)

Notice to Exhibitors:

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of current AAC rules and regulations including, but not limited to, the following:

This event will be held in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Agility Association of Canada (AAC). The obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the *AAC Official Rules and Regulations* and shall conform to AAC specifications.

All breeds and mixed breeds eighteen months of age and older (no exceptions) are eligible to compete. Blind, lame, or aggressive dogs are ineligible as are bitches in season, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance (judge's discretion).

All dogs must have an AAC Registration Number before their entries will be accepted in an AAC sanctioned trial, even if to compete FEO. The registration form is available at www.aac.ca

Dogs with numbers pending will not be eligible to compete.

No toys, food, or other training devices shall be allowed in the ring **with the exception** of an NFC or FEO run. Only during predetermined NFC or FEO runs can a handler run with a non-squeaking toy. Ultimately it is the judge's discretion if said toy is appropriate.

All dogs must be under control (ie. penned, crated, or leashed) when not in the ring. There will be no refunds for entries if the dog or handler is *dismissed* from the competition for any reason.

Electronic timing, breakaway tire, two piece jumps and rubberized contacts will be used at the trial.

Tunnel Hugger – Tunnel plates used for optimum safety and drastic reduction of tunnel movement

Entries:

- ❖ For the Love of Dog! reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- ❖ Anyone not in good standing with AAC / For the Love of Dog! will not be allowed to enter the trial.
- ❖ **We accept e- transfers only** Transfer to: fortheloveofdogpei@outlook.com
If prompted, please make the security password answer **agility**
- ❖ Refunds will not be given for cancellations after the closing date except for injury to a dog (veterinarian certificate required), or handler, which physically prevents them from competing. Refunds requested for any other reason will be handled on a case by case basis and will be at the discretion of For the Love of Dog!
- ❖ By AAC rules, entries are not valid until payment of entry fees has been received or confirmed.

AAC CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

STARTERS: Open to dogs that have not earned a Starters title.

ADVANCED: Open to dogs that have not earned an Advanced title.

MASTERS: Open to dogs that have earned an Advanced title. In these classes there are 3 divisions in each class.

STANDARD: Dogs will jump standard heights and course times as set by AAC.

VETERANS: for dogs 7 years of age or older, in the case of dogs currently competing in any Standard Agility Class. This class shall also be for dogs of 5 years of age or older who have been competing in Specials for a minimum of one calendar year. A dog may no longer compete in the Standard classes once entered in an official trial in any of the Veteran classes. Course times and jump heights will be per AAC rules.

SPECIALS: Open to all dogs. Course times and jump heights will be as per AAC rules. A dog may no longer compete in the Standard classes once entered at an official trial in any of the Special classes at an official trial in any of the Special classes except that they may move to the Veteran classes.

**** Notice to all Junior Handlers:** To promote the sport of agility to all younger handlers, we are offering a reduced fee for all runs. For our Junior Handlers we are offering \$10.00 per run.

JUNIOR HANDLERS

- ❖ Junior Handlers must have their own AAC Junior Handler ID.
- ❖ A handler entered in the junior class may not compete in regular classes (including games) at the same AAC trial.
- ❖ Entry Fee: \$10.00 per class
- ❖ It is the responsibility of the Junior Handler / Guardian to be aware of the AAC rules pertaining to the Junior Handler Program.

RIBBONS

- ❖ All classes will receive flat ribbons for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th.
- ❖ Rosettes for Qualifying Runs or FTLOD Dollars valued at \$1 and can be used at any FTLOD future trials
- ❖ New Titling Ribbons! NEW ATChC Ribbons!
- ❖ Qualifying ribbons will be on a self serve basis. If you titled or wish to have FTLOD cue bucks, the competitor or an appointed affiliate must stay for the ribbon ceremony after the day's events on Sunday to collect.

OBSTACLE FAMILIARIZATION / WARM-UP AREA

- ❖ There will be no obstacle familiarization.
- ❖ Who actually reads an entire premium? We are giving away one \$25 Tim Horton's gift card to a randomly selected individual who mentions I Love For the Love of Dog! on their entry premium.
- ❖ A warm-up area will be provided outside as required by AAC rules. The warm-up area is for the use of dogs that are about to run.

BITCHES IN SEASON (BIS)

- ❖ BIS is now permitted. Please advise the host as soon as possible so that the running orders can be adjusted
- ❖ All BIS will go last in their height and division
- ❖ The owner is responsible for providing a towel or mat for the BIS to sit on at the start line.
