RULE CHANGE JAN 1, 2018 – All handlers must now present their height cards at check-in. To speed up this process we are asking that those with finished cards to please enclose a copy of your completed height card with your entry, so we can check you in before the trial. Those that still need a measurement to finish their cards, you can bring your card with you and check in during the measuring process.

RULE CHANGE 2024 – Tyre height change. Tyres will be set one height lower than the dog's jump height

Trial Information

PUMPKIN SPICED JUMP FINALE

This trial is being held in conjunction with a non-sanctioned Pumpkin Spiced Jump Finale!

Eligibility consideration: The same dog and handler are entered in both Friday night's Jumper 1 and 2

Teams that double eliminate in these two events are not eligible.

The top 50% of dogs from each height/division will take part for amazing prizes and awards in a JUMP FINALE on Sunday Oct 27th.

Time plus faults. Each infraction has an added 3 second fault to their overall time

3 categories for the JUMP FINALE winner's circle: Small (4" – 8"), Medium (12" – 16"), Large (20" – 24")

Special and Vets will be given a time adjustment to their favor

Course difficulty will be deemed an Advanced Course

Measuring:

Regular measuring will be done Friday evening at 4:00pm and Saturday morning at 7:30am only - prior to the beginning of judging.

Volunteer List:

The volunteer list will be posted at the gate the day of the trial. Please check the volunteer list carefully and if there is a conflict, try and resolve the conflict amongst yourselves, however, make sure the changes are printed on the volunteer list.

Notice to Exhibitors:

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of current AAC rules and regulations including, but not limited to, the following:

This event will be held in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Agility Association of Canada (AAC). The obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the *AAC Official Rules and Regulations* and shall conform to AAC specifications.

All breeds and mixed breeds eighteen months of age and older (no exceptions) are eligible to compete. Blind, lame, or aggressive dogs are ineligible as are bitches in season, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance (judge's discretion).

All dogs must have an AAC Registration Number before their entries will be accepted in an AAC sanctioned trial, even if to compete FEO. The registration form is available at www.aac.ca

Dogs with numbers pending will not be eligible to compete.

No toys, food, or other training devices shall be allowed in the ring **with the exception** of an NFC or FEO run. Only during predetermined NFC or FEO runs can a handler run with a non-squeaking toy. Ultimately it is the judge's discretion if said toy is appropriate.

All dogs must be under control (ie. penned, crated, or leashed) when not in the ring. There will be no refunds for entries if the dog or handler is *dismissed* from the competition for any reason.

Electronic timing, breakaway tire, two piece jumps and rubberized contacts will be used at the trial.

Tunnel Hugger – Tunnel plates used for optimum safety and drastic reduction of tunnel movement

Entries:

- ❖ For the Love of Dog! reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- ❖ Anyone not in good standing with AAC / For the Love of Dog! will not be allowed to enter the trial.

If prompted, please make the security password answer **agility**

- ❖ Refunds will not be given for cancellations after the closing date except for an injury to a dog (veterinarian certificate required) which physically prevents the dog from competing. Refunds requested for any other reason will be handled on a case by case basis and will be at the discretion of For the Love of Dog!
- ❖ By AAC rules, entries are not valid until payment of entry fees has been received or confirmed.

AAC CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

STARTERS: Open to dogs that have not earned a Starters title.

ADVANCED: Open to dogs that have not earned an Advanced title.

MASTERS: Open to dogs that have earned an Advanced title. In these classes there are 3 divisions in each class.

STANDARD: Dogs will jump standard heights and course times as set by AAC.

VETERANS: for dogs 7 years of age or older, in the case of dogs currently competing in any Standard Agility Class. This class shall also be for dogs of 5 years of age or older who have been competing in Specials for a minimum of one calendar year. A dog may no longer compete in the Standard classes once entered in an official trial in any of the Veteran classes. Course times and jump heights will be per AAC rules.

SPECIALS: Open to all dogs. Course times and jump heights will be as per AAC rules. A dog may no longer compete in the Standard classes once entered at an official trial in any of the Special classes at an official trial in any of the Special classes except that they may move to the Veteran classes.

**** Notice to all Junior Handlers:** To promote the sport of agility to all younger handlers, we are offering a reduced fee for all runs. For our Junior Handlers we are offering \$10.00 per run.

JUNIOR HANDLERS

- ❖ Junior Handlers must have their own AAC Junior Handler ID.
- ❖ A handler entered in the junior class may not compete in regular classes (including games) at the same AAC trial.
- ❖ Entry Fee: \$10.00 per class
- ❖ It is the responsibility of the Junior Handler / Guardian to be aware of the AAC rules pertaining to the Junior Handler Program.

RIBBONS

- ❖ All classes will receive flat ribbons for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th.
- ❖ Rosettes for Qualifying Runs or FTLOD Dollars valued at \$1 and can be used at any FTLOD future trials
- ❖ New Titling Ribbons!
- ❖ Ribbon ceremony for the Pumpkin Spiced Jump Off will be awarded Sunday afternoon after the day's events.
- ❖ Qualifying ribbons will be on a self serve basis. If you titled or wish to have FTLOD cue bucks, the competitor or an appointed affiliate must stay for the ribbon ceremony after the day's events on Sunday to collect.

OBSTACLE FAMILIARIZATION / WARM-UP AREA

- ❖ There will be no obstacle familiarization.
